### Old Forester Fashioned \$11

Bourbon, sugar, black walnut bitters, orange, cherry, big cube.

Old Forester (America's first bottled bourbon) is consumed by customers of The Pilot and The Index,

the 2 bars in which Hemingway's final short story is set. It was also the only whiskey found at his house in Cuba after his death.

**Hemingway Daquiri                    \$11**

Rum, Luxardo, lime, grapefruit, up.  
Papa was diabetic and thought that replacing the sugar syrup with maraschino liquor and grapefruit juice might delay his demise.

**Pauline's Preference                    \$11**

Gin, lemon, strawberry, sugar, up.  
In a history of local ranches, Polly Copeland remembered Hemingway's second wife Pauline mixing these for ranch guests while Ernest read from "The Fifth Column", his only play.

**General Store Rusty Nail                    \$12**

Equal parts Teachers Scotch and Drambuie.  
Final drafts of "To Have and Have Not" and "Death in the Afternoon" were sent from the Cooke City General Store. Former owner, Sam Brady remembered the author buying Teachers Highland Cream by the case.
